

**Lortet, Louis[-Charles]** (1836–1909). French parasitologist, botanist, and zoologist in Lyon; lecturer in zoology at the Faculté des Sciences, Lyon 1874–1877; director of the Muséum d'Histoire Naturelle de Lyon; professor of natural history at the Faculté mixte de Médecine et de Pharmacie, 1877–1906.

**Lucas, Pierre Hippolyte** (1814–1899). French invertebrate zoologist; born in the Jardin des Plantes in Paris; began working in the museum at age 13; later, obtained the “Chaire d'entomologie” at the museum; worked on arachnids and various insects.

NAME: Lucas most commonly used the initial “H.” in his scientific publications.



AUTHORSHIP: Lucas was responsible for the 3 volumes entitled *Histoire naturelle des animaux articulés*. J. Macquart is the author of the Diptera, p. 414–503, in volume 3.

PUBL.: The entire *Exploration scientifique* was published in 25 volumes, 1844–1867. The "Zoologie" portion is comprised of 5 volumes, published

from 1845–1867. The *Histoire naturelle des animaux articulés* was published in 33 livraisons comprising 3 volumes, 1845–1849. Each of the three volumes bears the printed date “1849”. The Diptera are in part 3 of the third volume (which includes the last [= 33rd] livraison). The collation and dating below is taken from Sherborn & Woodward (1901), Baker (1994), and research conducted during this study.

[*Wiegmann's Archiv für Naturgesch.* 1849 noted some Lepidoptera on these pages as being published in 1848, but there are no specific dates. The Société Entomologique de France recorded receiving livraisons 13–18 on 22 December 1847, but there is no indication of text pages included in those livraisons. The last livraison of this volume (19) was issued after July 1848.]

Livr. 19. ??–590. Between July 1848 and 13 June 1849.

[P. 562 refers to a Lucas article in the *Rev. Zool. Soc. Cuvier.* for July 1848, so this livraison must have been issued after that date.]

REMARKS: Plates were issued along with the livraisons. The completed atlas of plates was issued with the text volumes in 1849. Dating and collation of the separate plates and more details on publication of livraisons in volumes 2 and 3 is desired. Although Baker (1994) researched the dating of the Hymenoptera portion of this work (vol. 3, part 3, p. 141–344), which helps with

some of the dating, still no conclusive evidence has been found to give better dates of publication for each livraison.


